



District Advisory Committee (DAC)

FACT SHEET

Purpose

- The purpose of the District Advisory Committee (DAC) is to advise the district regarding its Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)
- The LCAP is a State plan required by the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)

Membership

- The DAC consists of one selected School Site Council (SSC) member from each school in the district
- Each representative is selected by their SSC
- The DAC includes a broad representation of the student/parent population served by the district

Meetings

- DAC meetings are open to the public
- The district will convene the DAC at least four times each year to complete the LCAP development and review process
- Other meetings will be convened if necessary

Roles and Responsibilities

- Review the district's LCAP data dashboard for each of the State's identified eight priority areas
- Review the Supplemental and Concentration funds allocated for programs and services for English Learners, Low-income students and Foster Youth
- Advise the district on the allocation of future supplemental and concentration funding in the LCAP
